Nominations to shape the future of irrigation close on Wednesday (May 8).

Irrigators interested in making a difference in their local community have until Wednesday to submit an expression of interest to join an interim board.

Interim boards are being established in Bundaberg, Burdekin, Emerald, Eton, Lower Mary, Mareeba, St George and Theodore to put the case for local management of SunWater's eight channel irrigation schemes.

The Queensland government has set up an independent project team to support the interim boards as they investigate an option for local management and ownership of the schemes.
