Dear Irrigation Customer

I am pleased to advise that the Lower Mary Interim Board has submitted its Business Proposal to Government following its investigation of the option of local management of the Lower Mary irrigation scheme.

On behalf of the Interim Board I would like to thank water users for the feedback provided on the proposal, which has examined many of the complex issues involved in transferring ownership of the channel assets to an irrigator-owned company.


After consultation with the scheme's water users, including our customer meeting earlier this month, irrigators, holding approximately 70 per cent of the total water allocation in the scheme, indicated support for further investigation of local management arrangements for the Lower Mary.

Business Proposals from eight of SunWater's channel schemes are currently with the Independent Chair of the LMA project team, Leith Bouilly, who will provide our Lower Mary proposal to Government at the end of the month, followed by her recommendations on whether local management of SunWater's eight schemes should proceed.

Representatives from the interim board will be presenting our proposal to Queensland Treasury Corporation on Monday 16 July. A decision from government in relation to whether local management should proceed in the Lower Mary is expected by the end of the year.
